## ORDINANCE NO. 2011-50

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH GREAT LAKES CRUSHING, LTD. FOR THE CAMELOT COURT IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Camelot Court Improvements on June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Great Lakes Crushing, LTD. of Eastlake, Ohio for the referenced Camelot Court Improvements has been reviewed and found to be in conformance with all contract requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Great Lakes Crushing, LTD. of Eastlake, Ohio for a cost not to exceed **\$113, 370.25.**

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.

**SECTION 3.** The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of a Municipal Department and further reason being that the execution of this contract is necessary within 60 days of the bid opening date; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
