ORDINANCE 2012 – 5

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH CONCORD ROAD EQUIPMENT MFG., INC. FOR TWO CONCORD MINUTEMAN SEVERE DUTY DUMP BODY SNOW & ICE CONTROL EQUIPMENT PACKAGES AS PROVIDED THROUGH THE STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$103,824.84 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on December 8, 2011, by motion granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids for two 2012 or newer front snow plows, rear salt spreader dump trucks as recommended by the Service Director and the City's Road Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on February 23, 2012 adopted <u>Ordinance No.</u> <u>2012-4</u>, authorizing and directing the Mayor to accept the bid and to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Valley Ford Sterling Freightliner & Western Trucks of Cleveland for the purchase of two 2012 Model 108SD Conventional Chassis/Set Back Axle Trucks at a total price not to exceed \$151,824.00 for both trucks; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of the Willoughby Hills has reviewed the recommendation provided by the Road Supervisor, Nate Catania in his Service Department Report on Vehicle Status submitted to Mayor Weger, on January 19, 2012 to equip the two abovementioned trucks with a combination dump body/rear spreader packages installed by Concord Road Equipment MFG., Inc. of Painesville, Ohio under the State of Ohio Purchasing Program at a cost of \$51,912.42 for each truck; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills approves of the purchase of two combination dump body/rear spreader packages and related accessories provided through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program by utilizing funds from Fund #250 – Street Construction, Maintenance & Repair and Fund #270 – Road levy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement with Concord Road Equipment MFG., Inc., 348 Chester Street, P. O. Box 772, Painesville, Ohio 44077 for the purchase of two Concord Minuteman Severe Duty Dump Body Snow & Ice Control Equipment Packages for a total price not to exceed \$103,824.84, substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the attached Quote, dated January 14, 2012, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", consisting of (2) pages and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, and further provides for the usual daily operation of the Service Department, and further reason being to secure the price as discounted under the Ohio Department of State Purchasing Contract Index Number STS515, Schedule Number 800116 for 2012 for the purchase of two Concord Minuteman Severe Duty Dump Body Snow & Ice Control Equipment Packages; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
