ORDINANCE NO. 2012-28

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE MAGISTRATE OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS MAYOR'S COURT; REPEALING CONFLICTING LEGISLATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 1905.05 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Mayor to appoint a person as Mayor's Court Magistrate; and

WHEREAS, Section 1905.05 of the Ohio Revised Code requires such Magistrate be paid a fixed annual salary set by this Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Interoffice Memo, dated May 16, 2012 from the Mayor to the President of Council, consisting of one page, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", the Mayor respectfully requested Council's approval of a one and a half percent (1.50%) increase in salary for services performed by the Magistrate of the Willoughby Hills Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has fixed by this Ordinance a compensation range and hereby provides to the Mayor, CEO and Head of the Administrative Branch of the Municipal Government, said fixed range for the Magistrate.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor's Court Magistrate shall receive the sum of Thirteen Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$13,400.00) annually, payable monthly at One Thousand, One Hundred Sixteen Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$1,116.67), as the fixed salary for services performed by the Magistrate of the Willoughby Hills Mayor's Court, such salary to be retroactive to January 1, 2012.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. All the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation a municipal department, and further provides for the salary and compensation of the Willoughby Hills Mayor's Court Magistrate, with said salary and compensation to be retroactive to January 1, 2012; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
