AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SECURE THE PURCHASE OF A NEW FIRE TRUCK FROM FINLEY FIRE EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Willoughby Hills has accepted the recommendation of the Fire Chief to purchase a new fire truck from Finley Fire Equipment and as substantiated by the Interoffice Memorandum from the Finance Director to Mayor Robert M. Weger and Members of the Finance Committee, dated May 30, 2012, consisting of six (6) pages, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference establishes the estimated total cost of purchasing, financing, and equipping the truck to be approximately \$450,000; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills approves the immediate purchase of said vehicle by incorporating the financing proposal outlined in **Exhibit "A"**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all necessary documents to secure the purchase, financing and equip a new fire truck from Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. of 2600 American Drive, Appleton, WI 54912 at **a total cost not to exceed \$450,000**.

SECTION 2. Vehicle is being purchased through the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) Contract #800180; purchasing and terms provided by listed vendor Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. of 2600 American Drive, Appleton, WI 54912.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills, insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the Fire Department, and further reason being that this will allow the City to utilize the Price and Payment as outline in the Purchase Agreement of Pierce Manufacturing Inc., for said Fire Truck provided through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract #800180 without jeopardizing the availability of the vehicle; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
