RESOLUTION NO. 2008-13

A RESOLUTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS TO SUPPORT AND ENDORSE AN APPLICATION FOR CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) FUNDS TO NOACA FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SHARED-USE PATH ALONG SOM CENTER ROAD (S.R. 91) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a joint effort has been initiated by the Cities of Willoughby Hills and Willoughby to develop an alternate mode of transportation along SOM Center Road (S.R. 91); and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Willoughby Hills and Willoughby believe the development of a shared-use path will serve to mitigate traffic congestion and improve air quality along S.R. 91 and will link with an existing shared-use path at the Willoughby Hills/Mayfield Village corporation limit to an existing shared-use path at Curtis Boulevard in Eastlake; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills recognizes that such an undertaking requires financial assistance in the form of federal aid and desires to utilize available federal financial resources to support the SOM Center Road Shared-Use Path Improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills will participate and assume its appropriate non-federal matching share; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Willoughby Hills and Willoughby will work cooperatively with all affected agencies and develop cooperative agreements as deemed necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills intends to abide by all NOACA policies as is applicable to this improvement; and

WHEREAS, it was agreed that the City of Willoughby will serve as the lead agency in submitting an application for CMAQ funds to NOACA for this improvement.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to work cooperatively with the City of Willoughby to endorse and/or execute an application for CMAQ funding to NOACA for the construction of a Shared-Use Path along SOM Center Road (S.R. 91).


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. his Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to comply with the NOACA application deadline of December 1, 2008 for CMAQ funds; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




