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**A RESOLUTION BY THE ADMINISTRATION AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS TO SUPPORT AND ENDORSE AN APPLICATION FOR AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 (FEDERAL STIMULUS) FUNDING FOR TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION AND ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS ALONG SOM CENTER ROAD (S.R. 91) AND EUCLID CHARDON ROAD (U.S. 6) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

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**WHEREAS**, a new traffic signal is warranted at the S.R. 91/Classic Drive/Corporate 90 intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, a new S.R. 91 northbound right turn lane onto the I-90 eastbound on-ramp is justified; and

**WHEREAS**, interconnecting traffic signals and adding emergency vehicle preemption equipment to existing traffic signals along S.R. 91 and U.S. 6 will improve traffic conditions and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, resurfacing S.R. 91 will improve a deteriorated roadway pavement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Willoughby Hills recognizes that such an undertaking requires financial assistance in the form of federal aid and desires to utilize available federal financial resources to support the improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Willoughby Hills will participate and assume its appropriate non-federal share if necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Willoughby Hills intends to abide by all NOACA policies as is applicable to this improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Willoughby Hills will serve as the lead agency for any improvements associated with this project which are located in the City of Willoughby.

***NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO THAT:***

**SECTION 1.** The City Engineer is hereby authorized to endorse and/or execute an application for federal funding to NOACA for the signalization and roadway improvements along SOM Center Road (S.R. 91) and Euclid Chardon Road (U.S. 6).

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Community; and for the further reason that the City has been requested to file the application immediately by NOACA in order to remain eligible to receive federal funds; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
