RE: Update on Pleasant Valley Road Bridge Closure

This update is in follow up to my letter to you dated December 7, 2017, in which I notified you of the updates on the Pleasant Valley Road Bridge maintenance issues requiring temporary closure of the bridge by the Lake County Engineer. In that letter, we anticipated the bridge repair to be performed in mid to late January.

Our Road Superintendent, Mark Grubiss, provided me with an update today that I wanted to pass along to you, hoping this will be the third and final notification to residents to keep them updated on this very important project. He advised me that U.S. Bridge has the bearing plates close to being complete in the manufacturing process and they anticipate to start the repair on approximately February 15th, weather permitting. Once the work begins, we could expect that it will be 2 to 3 days for the repair. The bridge would be opened immediately thereafter.

Again, thank you for your patience during this bridge closure. It is greatly appreciated.
