RESOLUTION NO. 2020-03

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE NOPEC 2020 COMMUNITY EVENT SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM & AWARD ACCEPTANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Hills has renewed its participation in the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) Community Event Sponsorship Program; and

WHEREAS, the Program is designed to provide financial support to organizations within the community that host events that are accessible to residents; and

WHEREAS, NOPEC wants to continue to help support events in their member communities which rely on donations and are free and open to the public; and

WHEREAS, the amount of funds disbursed to the City is determined by the average number of enrolled residential/business gas and/or electric accounts during the 2nd and 3rd quarters of 2019; and

WHEREAS, The City of Willoughby Hills wishes to participate in the NOPEC 2020 Community Event Sponsorship Program to receive and accept a sponsorship award in the amount of \$1,500 to be used by the Recreation Department for this year's Rock N Roll Day in Willoughby Hills to be held on Saturday, August 8, 2020.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Council supports the submittal and acceptance of the attached disbursement form, consisting of four (4) pages, attached hereto as "Exhibit A" to participate in the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) 2020 Community Event Sponsorship Program and thereby be eligible to receive and accept a sponsorship award in the amount of \$1,500.00 to be used by the City's Recreation Department.

SECTION 2. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the municipality. Said emergency being that the deadline for submission of the disbursement form is no later than March 31, 2020, with requests not submitted by March 31, 2020, not being processed. Wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.

City Engineer DiFranco responded to Ms. Fulton's question regarding the wrong address being on the PC-ABR agenda as it related to sign approval. He indicated that the sign was reviewed and approved on the building, not the address and it does not require going through approval again, but will check on the error as he was unaware of the address error. He also indicated that the public has an opportunity to learn about drainage with the upcoming Master Rain Garden classes being offered in the winter through the summer, with at least four courses being offered by a group put together by CRWP, Lake Soil & Water Conservation District, NEORSD, Dominion Ohio Energy and Western Reserve Land Conservancy. They are being offered at the Chagrin Metroparks, Mayfield Village Community Center, Holden Arboretum and two are available on line. City Engineer DiFranco explained that a rain garden can help with drainage of your yard if you have flooding or wet areas. They beautify your yard since they are filled with plants and can attract birds, butterflies and other animals. More information can be obtained at the CRWP website. He believes there is a \$50 fee, which entitles you to a t-shirt and certificate.
