RESOLUTION NO. 2016-12

A RESOLUTION FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF A 2016 LAKE COUNTY CDBG AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,000 TO FINANCE THE INSTALLATION OF ADA ACCESSIBLE DOORS AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Communities Grants; and

WHEREAS, the Program provides annual grants on a formula basis to entitled cities and counties to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Urban Development (HUD) awards grants to entitlement community grantees to carry out a wide range of community development activities directed toward revitalizing neighborhoods, economic development, and providing improved community facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2016 the Council adopted Resolution No. 2016-5 authorizing and directing the Mayor to submit an application on behalf of the City to participate in the Lake County Community Development Block Grant Program FY2016 seeking funding for the installation of ADA accessible doors for the City Hall Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the County will release funding for the project in December of this year with the appropriation of funds to be included as part of the 2017 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvement will improve accessibility to the Police Department and to City Hall for physically challenged individuals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Willoughby Hills hereby accepts the 2016 Lake County CDBG Award in the amount of \$11,000 from the Lake County Development Block Program. Said funds will be used exclusively for the installation of ADA Accessible Doors at the entrance to the Police Department.

SECTION 2. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were held in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and take effect at the earliest time as permitted by law.
