- It sounds like Willoughby Hills is still well ahead of the curve. Even if the FAA approves the Master Plan the airport owner / operator will still have to comply with all environmental reviews before a grain of sand can be moved. So there is plenty of time to formulate and implement a strategy and plan.
- The Community Coalition is a great idea on many levels.
- I agree that the coalition should be the one to retain experts, including legal counsel.
- I would like to be considered if and when it is determined to be time to do so. I can also suggest some engineering consultants.
