Secretary Mary Peters has asked me to respond to your letter of April 16 regarding the Cuyahoga County Airport Draft Master Plan and the potential impacts on the city of Willoughby Hills.

The Federal Aviation Administration understands your interest in the proposed development at Cuyahoga County Airport. We have reviewed the information submitted and will take it under advisement as we review any updated planning documents for the airport. The airport sponsor initially submitted the Final Draft Airport Master Plan Report, Runway Safety Area Study, and Airport Layout Plan (ALP) for FAA review. However, on March 14, the sponsor withdrew them.

Therefore, until the airport sponsor completes any updated planning studies and the FAA reviews them, the ALP dated December 10, 1982 remains in effect. This ALP does not depict any airport expansion into the city of Willoughby Hills. We request that you continue working with the airport sponsor as the sponsor completes additional work on these studies.

I trust this information is helpful.
