RECREATION COORDINATOR'S REPORT

Lake County Captains Willoughby Hills Appreciation Day (June 14) – 75 tickets sold to date. Information regarding Corn Fest will be distributed at this event. **Golf Sports Camp** registration slowed down. Hoping by camp start there will be enough for each camp. Plan 3 golf camps –Pre-K, Beginner and Intermediate. Info has gone to the schools. **Tennis Camp** (June 22 – June 26) slow but steady, **Otto Orf Soccer Camp** (July 20-24). **Safety Town** (July 27-31) getting a good response. **Day Camp** (June 15 to August 7) named Summer Harvest with each week focusing on a special theme. Good registration - limit 35 – currently at 25 – 19 from Willoughby Hills. University Hospital Richmond Heights has donated \$500. Eaton Family Credit Union has donated \$200. Field trips to: James A. Garfield Historic Site, Penitentiary Glen, Cleveland Metroparks Zoo, Captains Game, Chagrin Valley Nature Center, and Cleveland Museum of Art. **Softball** – 8 teams.
