AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ONTARIO STONE CORP. FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIMESTONE FOR THE YEAR 2013 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills on February 28, 2013, by motion, granted the Mayor authorization to advertise for bids to secure the City’s requirement of limestone for the year 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Willoughby Hills has reviewed and accepts the recommendations as provided by the Mayor in his Memorandum, dated April 12, 2013 directed to Council President and Council Clerk, attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”**, consisting of nine (9) pages and incorporated herein by reference, finding the following bid of: **\$15.95** per ton for ODOT #304 Limestone; **\$15.95** per ton for ODOT #411 Limestone; **\$18.80** per ton for ODOT #57 Limestone; and **\$18.80** per ton for ODOT #1 and #2 Limestone Blend as submitted by Ontario Stone Corp. to be the lowest and best bid in conformance with all contract requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid as submitted by Ontario Stone Corp. of 1246 River Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44113, substantially pursuant to the terms and conditions as identified in the bid, opened on March 22, 2013, attached hereto as part of Exhibit “A”, consisting of nine (9) pages and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to return all bid bonds to the unsuccessful bidders.

SECTION 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were conducted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby Hills.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Willoughby Hills insofar as it provides for the usual daily operation of the City’s Service Department, and further reason to allow the City to accept the bid and enter into a contract with Ontario Stone Corporation; wherefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
