Dear Resident:

The City of Willoughby Hills continues to address the repair of Rogers Road following the recent landslide which washed away much of the road. As the repairs progress, we want to keep the residents, particularly in that area, apprised of the process that will be taking place.


We are presently working with Geo Tech Engineering to design a permanent solution for this repair. We have already worked diligently to secure an emergency repair State grant in the amount of \$150,000, as well as \$50,000 in a 0% loan. We anticipate the total cost of the project to be approximately \$300,000.

On Monday, December 5, 2011, Rogers Road will be open to westbound traffic (down the hill only). Rogers Road will be closed at the hill to eastbound traffic. Once construction actually commences on the project, we may be forced to close the road completely; however, while design and engineering are being finalized, we can safely allow traffic to be maintained on this limited basis. Adequate safety barriers have been set up by our Service Department to direct motorists accordingly.

Since the project will involve concrete and asphalt, our timeline for project completion at this time cannot be determined. These materials cannot be placed in frigid temperatures. We are working to complete this project as soon as possible. We will keep you posted and refer you to our city website (www.willoughbyhills-oh.gov) and WHTV for updates.
