**Subject:** Veto on Ordinance 2017-75

On October 26, 2017, five members of Council (Nancy Fellows, David Fiebig, John Plecnik, Janet Majka and Laura Pizmoht) passed Ordinance 2017-75, retaining Stephen L. Byron and Walter Haverfield LLP as the City's Acting Law Director. Previously, the same five members of Council passed Ordinance 2017-70 engaging the services of this same individual/firm.

It is my intention to hereby veto Ordinance 2017-75 because **it is in direct conflict with the lawsuit that that was filed under Ordinance 2017-70**. Until a legal determination is made as to the validity of Ordinance 2017-70, my veto should stand.

Incidentally, I do not regard my lawsuit as "frivolous litigation initiated by me," as state in Ordinance 2017-75, Sections 2 and 6; **OUR RESIDENTS DESERVE BETTER!**
